Residence Hall Information:

Freshman Housing Units: Freshmen are required to be housed in an apartment style housing unit. Rooms available are double (1-bedroom, 2 people) or triple occupancy (1-bedroom, 3 people) at a cost of \$1,095 plus utilities per term. Freshmen are not provided the opportunity to select the type of room they are assigned. Freshmen housing units may accommodate up to 6 students.

Upperclassman Housing Units: Upperclassman are required to be housed in a townhouse style housing unit. Rooms available are double occupancy (1-bedroom, 2 person) at a cost of \$1,395 plus utilities per term or single occupancy (1-bedroom, 1 person) at a cost of \$1,695 plus utilities per term.

Single Rooms: There are a limited number of single rooms available. Requests should be made in writing to the Housing and Security Director. The single room request must be made in addition to the housing application packet. **Single rooms are not guaranteed and may not always be available.** There is a higher rate for single rooms, \$1,695 plus utilities per term. Students with specific documented medical needs that prevent them from having a roommate may receive special consideration for a single room.

Optional: Roommate Preferences - honored whenever possible. The chances of being assigned with a requested roommate are increased if both applications and deposits are returned together, both individuals request each other. If no roommate request is made, roommates are assigned randomly without regard to race, creed, national origin, religion or sexual orientation. **We cannot guarantee building preference or roommate preference.**

Utilities:

The College agrees to appropriately furnish the leased premises (including air conditioning and kitchen facility).
